Dear Resident,

The Mayor and City Council would like to extend their gratitude and thanks for your support as our city strives to move forward.

On April 29, 2016 our city experienced the worst flooding incident on record. We received approximately 7" of rain in a 6 hour period on top of water logged conditions creating severe damage to our homes and property. It is fair to say recovery for all has been lengthy and difficult. The recovery of the City's infrastructure has been in the forefront of the Administrations' minds since the event. The process of rebuilding and improving the City's storm water drainage is being addressed and a strategic plan is being developed with the help of various civil engineering professionals.

At this time, a history needs to be gathered of areas that flooded. This history will assist in the determination of areas needing stormwater studies. These studies need to be prioritized based on areas affected most often.

Please take a moment to document on this form any flooding your home received **prior** to or after April 29th 2016. *For the purpose of this survey we will define flooding as actual water penetration in to your home.*
